Re: Works to former Morrison's Petrol Station site, Chalk Farm Road, Camden

Dear Neighbour,

We write to inform you that we are applying to Camden to temporarily extend our working hours from Tuesday 1st September until Thursday 3rd September 2020 and wanted to ensure, as a local resident or business, you are aware of why we need to do this and how it may impact you.

We will be applying to extend our works on the days noted, until 21:00 to allow us to carry out Power Floating to the new Morrison's Store floor on Chalk Farm Road.

Power floating is an operation that is carried out during the later stages of curing the concrete slab, by running a small machine (a large lawn mower size) across it to create a hardwearing polished finish.

As the speed of the concrete curing is influenced by environmental conditions, it may result in us needing to carry out this process later in the day than we would like, hence our application and writing to the local residents.

During the warmer months of the year this process is significantly quicker than the colder months, but we felt it only reasonable to inform you that these works may overrun to the time above. If this does happen, the disruption caused will be limited to the noise generated by the small petrol engine machine that is used for this operation.
